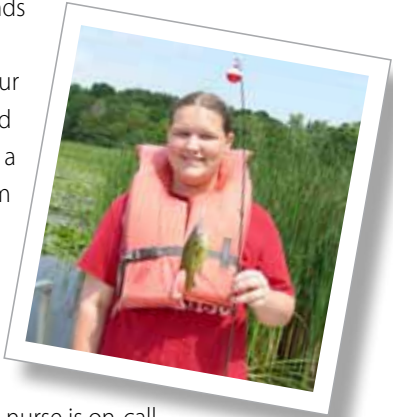


Creative Options offers respite care weekends specifically designed for children and adults with special needs. The unique settings of Camp Friendship and Eden Wood Center encourage our participants to enjoy activities that are different from their usual schedules. There are many indoor and outdoor options to choose. Activities vary with the season and may include sports and games, crafts, music and dancing, sledding, snow sculpture, cross-country skiing, hiking and biking, canoeing, paddle boats, fishing, swimming, campfires and more.

The program lets individuals relax and reenergize while their family or care provider enjoys a break from the daily demands of caring for a person with special needs. Our program, facilities, and caring staff make this a safe, "home away from home" experience. Care and supervision are provided by the same high quality staff as all Friendship Ventures programs. A nurse is on-call during the weekend.



Who can participate?

Children and adults with developmental disabilities, often in combination with autism, epilepsy, hearing and visual impairment, cerebral palsy, physical and other disabilities, are eligible to attend. Opportunities are also available for brothers, sisters and friends without disabilities to attend any respite weekend. All ages are accepted.

This program is operated in accordance with the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, sexual orientation, and marital or family status.

Friendship Getaway Weekends, an option for the person who is looking for a vacation that they are involved in choosing activities that are interesting and challenging. Activities are designed to support independence with guidance and direction from counselors and other staff. Eligibility includes ages 16 and older, ability to complete their daily living skills with minimal assistance, can be unsupervised for a short period of time and will have a 1:5 staff to participant ratio.

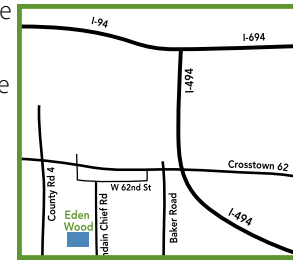

Locations:

Creative Options programs are offered at Camp Friendship near Annandale and at Eden Wood Center in Eden Prairie. Each site offers home-like, accessible cabins, with living space for both staff and respite participants in the same building.

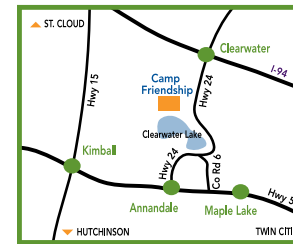
EDEN WOOD CENTER in Eden Prairie is located in a southwest suburb of the Twin Cities area.

From Interstate 494: Take Crosstown Highway 62 west to the South Frontage Road/W. 62nd Street stoplight. Take a left at the stoplight and then an immediate right onto Indian Chief Road. Go 2/10 of a mile south on Indian Chief Road. The entrance to Eden Wood Center will be on your right.



CAMP FRIENDSHIP is located one hour northwest of the Twin Cities, 7 miles north of Annandale and only 22 miles from St. Cloud.

From I-94: Take I-94 to Highway 24 south (Clearwater Exit, #178). Go 7.5 miles, turn right onto 108th Street NW and continue .7 miles to the camp entrance.



From Highway 55: Take Highway 55 to Wright County Road 6. Go north on Cty. Rd. 6 for 2.6 miles to the stop sign. Turn right onto Highway 24 and drive 2.3 miles. Turn left onto 108th Street NW and continue .7 miles to the camp entrance.

How to Register

Select the weekend(s) that interest you. If you have completed a Friendship Ventures application this year, simply contact our office to register. Otherwise, complete an application. If you do not have an application call (952) 852-0101 or (800) 450-8376, or e-mail fv@friendshipventures.org. Forms are also available to download from our website, in the forms library. Application materials, along with a \$250 deposit, will be accepted by mail, e-mail, hand delivery or fax. When registered, you will receive a letter confirming the weekend(s), along with:

- Check-in and check-out times, a clothing list and directions to camp
- A physical exam form and other relevant forms. (We request that each participant have a physical within 24 months of attendance. If you are unable to provide records, please contact our Director of Registration).
- To ensure a quality experience, only a limited number of people who have behavioral considerations or require special personal or medical care will be accepted.

Day Trips

Day trips have become a popular option for some of the weekend stays. Depending on the group, day trip activities may be scheduled without additional cost. If additional money is needed, you will be notified in advance. Groups have gone out for pizza, to a college football game, bowling, out to dinner and to an ice show. Other options may include a Saturday matinee, a visit to a museum, roller skating, ice skating and more.

Fees

A \$250 registration fee is requested and will be applied to the total weekend cost. Fees for the entire weekend are based on the level of supervision and care needed, living situation, and eligibility for county contract respite funding for the individual.

Cancellations and Refunds

- A full refund will be given if our office receives notice 15 days prior to the applicant's session.
- A partial refund will be given if our office receives notice less than 15 days prior to the applicant's session. (All fees refunded except the \$250 registration fee.)
- If an applicant cancels less than 15 days prior to the session, and has not paid the \$250 registration fee, they will be billed for that amount.

Fees will be pro-rated if the person will not be attending the entire weekend. Please indicate the length of stay on the application form or by contacting our office directly.

Note to Parents/Caregivers: Children and adults who are eligible for county funds, or CADI, TBI, consumer directed MR/RC or DD waiver funds for respite care, please contact our office for additional information of how these funds can be utilized for respite weekend fees.
